**Day**

*Saturday, March 9*

***The start of your amazing journey***

Departure from North America. Flight usually arrives in Jordan the next day.

Make sure to arrive at the airport 3 hours before your scheduled departure.

**Day**

*Sunday, March 10*

***Welcome to Jordan!***

Arrival in **Amman/Aqaba** per flight itinerary. Meet and be assisted by a Lipkin Tours representative responsible for your tour in Jordan and Israel. Your first night will be spent in Amman/Aqaba

**Overnight in a hotel in Amman/Aqaba**

**Day**

*Monday, March 11*

***Petra, Jordan***

After breakfast we will drive to **Petra**, one of the Seven Wonders of the World. We will start with a group orientation in Petra followed by lunch after which we will tour the amazing remains of the 10,000 year old city. Petra was once a Nabataean caravan-city, half-built and half-carved in the rocks and surrounded by mountains riddled with passages and gorges. It is also one of the most famous archaeological sites in the world, where ancient Eastern traditions blend with Hellenistic architecture.

**Dinner and overnight in Petra hotel.**

**Day**

*Tuesday, March 12*

**Jordan**

We will start the day off at the **tomb of Aaron** which sits on the peak of Jabal Harun (possible location of Mt Hor) in Petra.

Next, we will visit **Karak**, or biblically known as Kir of Moab, an important city and stronghold of Moab. Isaiah the prophet prophesied against Kir of Moab, and it is recorded in Isaiah 15

We will then travel to the church of **Mabada** where Satan and Michael battled for the body of Moses. Mabada was once a Moabite border city, mentioned in Numbers 21:30 and Joshua 13:9.

We will end the day by going to **Mt Nebo**, where Moses saw the Holy Land that he was forbidden from entering (Deuteronomy 32:48-52).

**Day**

*Wednesday, March 13*

**Jordan**

We will begin the day by visiting **Jerash**, one of the Ten Cities of Decapolis. In Mark 7:31 it tells of Jesus going through the coasts of Decapolis.

Next, we will go to **Tel Deir Allah**, possibly the location of biblical Succoth, and see the Balaam inscription. The inscription dates to the 800s BCE and includes fragments from a vision of Balaam son of Beor and his reaction to the vision.

We will then go to **Tel El Hammam**, a possible site of biblical Sodom and where Lot went and dwelt after separating from Abraham (Genesis 13:11).

We will end the day at **Qaser El Yahud** which is the crossing location of the Israelites into the Land of Israel from Jordan (Joshua 3:14-17)

**Dinner and overnight at Dead Sea hotel.**

**Day**

*Thursday, March 14*

**Welcome to Israel!**

We will cross into Israel via the **Allenby Bridge Crossing** following the route the Israelites took in their conquest of the Land of Israel. We will first go to **Tel El Sultat** which is the ancient city of Jericho (Jos 6). We will then visit **Elisha's springs**, located near Jericho, where Elisha performed the miracle of healing the water (2Kings 2:19-22).

Next, we will visit **Yafit and Argaman**. Next to both towns were two of five ancient holy sites/compounds used as a gathering place for holidays and worship in the early stages of the Israelites conquest of the Land of Israel. Each of the five compounds are shaped into an enormous foot. In Yafit we will see a topographic map. In Argaman we will visit the foot structure that makes up the area where thousands of people would gather and celebrate the festivals.

## Day

Friday, March 15

### Samaria

Our first stop of the day will be at **Shiloh**, Israel's first capital and where the Tabernacle stood for almost 400 years. It was here that Hannah prayed for a son and God gave her Samuel the prophet (1Sam 1). We will participate in an **archaeological dig** in the area surrounding the Tabernacle site.

Afterwards, we will visit **Givat Harel Altar**. This altar is near Tel Shiloh and was used by the ancient Israelites in their religious observances.

To wrap up the day we will visit **Maqatir**, possible site of Ai, the second city taken in the Israelite conquest of Canaan after the rebellion of Achan (Joshua 7).

Dinner and overnight at Jerusalem hotel.

## Day

Saturday, March 16

### Jerusalem

Rest day! Enjoy a walking tour of Jerusalem.

After lunch we will join King of Kings in their weekly service.

We will end the day with a lecture from Scott.

## Day

Sunday, March 17

### Hebron

Today will be spent in and around **Hebron** where David was first crowned king and the burial place of the Patriarchs.

We will visit **Tel Rumeida**, an archaeological park in which are structures dating back to the Canaanite period and is the oldest site in the city of Hebron.

Next, we will go to **David's palace**, the **Cave of Machpelah** which Abraham purchased from the Sons of Heth and where the Patriarchs are buried (Gen 23:3-20), and **Mamre** which is where Abraham dwelt and where he encountered the Angel of God (Gen 13:18, 18:1).

Dinner and overnight at Jerusalem hotel.

10

**Day**

*Monday, March 18*

*Jerusalem*

We will begin the day ascending the **Temple Mt**: the location of the binding of Isaac and where the first and second Temple stood. The Temple Mt was purchased by David from Arunah the Jebusite to build an altar to sacrifice to God in order to stop the plague from destroying the people. (2Sam 24:18-25)

Next, we will tour the **City of David** and the amazing archaeological finds that have been identified as the city that David lived in. The tour ends at the **Pool of Siloam** where Jesus sent the man blind from birth to wash and be healed (John 9:7).

**Dinner and overnight at Jerusalem hotel.**

11

**Day**

*Tuesday, March 19*

*Samaria*

We will have breakfast and check out of our hotel in Jerusalem before driving to **Shavey Shomron**, an Israeli town located in Samaria and our staging location for our day in Samaria.

We will then go to **Mt Ebal**, the Mt of Curses, where a huge Israelite altar was found and is attributed to the altar built by Joshua the servant of Moses for the ceremony of the blessings and the curses (Jos 8).

After lunch, we will visit **Mt. Gerizim**, the Mt of Blessings, and the capital town of the Samaritans. This is the mountain the Samaritans believed all people were to worship God from (John 4:19-24).

We will end the day on **Mt Kabir** where God promised the Land of Israel to Abraham and his descendants (Gen 12:6-7).

**Dinner and overnight in Petah Tikva hotel**

12

**Day**

*Wednesday, March 20*

*Shechem*

We will spend the day touring **Shechem** which is located in the valley below Mt Ebal and Mt Gerizim and is the ancient city mentioned in the bible where Jacob came to live after leaving Laban (Gen 33:18).

We will begin at **Tel Balata** identified as the biblical city of Shechem. Then we will visit **Jacob's well** where Jesus met and talked with the Samaritan woman (John 4:7) and **Joseph's tomb** (Jos 24:32). We will also visit the **Temple at To** which are the remains of the temple of Baal-Berith built in the time of the Judges after the death of Gideon (Judges 8:33).

We will wrap up by visiting the burial site of Joshua in **Kifl Haris** (Jos 24:30).

As our program comes to an end, we will have a **festive farewell dinner** thanking our staff for an amazing experience.
